








Women Entrepreneurship Program with DXC Technologies

The initiative aimed to empower individuals engaged in self-employment, was executed through a blended approach delivered in phases, consisting of three key interventions: ISB Program:

Catered to 300 beneficiaries, a blend of instructor-led sessions and self-paced virtual



learning, covering topics such as business fundamentals, management practices, identification of growth opportunities, effective leadership skills, access to finance, market linkages, and many more Champion Identification: From the ISB Program, 30 standout participants were identified as champions. They received mentorship sessions and incentive support to take ahead their entrepreneurial endeavors. IIT Bombay Course: The 30 champions facilitated a course from IIT Bombay, introducing 150 additional participants to computer knowledge essential for entrepreneurship.



Training of Transgenders

B&WSSC recently completed a skill development program focused on the LGBTQIA+ community. In this initiative, 20 individuals were trained in makeup at one of the finest academies - Blossom Kochhar College of Creative Arts & Design.

Bajaj Finserv Project

The skill development program was aimed to equip participants with specific skills in order to enhance their employability and designed career prospects. The program was to address the growing demand for skilled professionals in the Beauty and Wellness Sector. Total 180 participants were trained in job roles

which are high in demand in the industry – Beauty Therapist (60 cohorts), Hairdresser & Stylist (30 cohorts), Bridal Fashion and Portfolio Make-up Artist (30 cohorts), and Professional Make-up Artist (60 cohorts)

LinkedIn Program

B&WSSC collaborated with LinkedIn for the third consecutive year to take forward their CSR mandate. LinkedIn has always been focused on enhancing the entrepreneurial skills of the youth. This year program was also focused on supporting 4050 women and youth who are either job seekers, currently employed or



entrepreneurs with digital skills to increase their economic opportunities. The program was a total of 20 hours of training covering modules like Digital literacy, financial literacy, Industry specific skills and training on LinkedIn app.

Early introduction of skill courses helps young women make informed life choices. With this in mind, B&WSSC, in association with Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya, conducted training programs for students from 6th to 12th grade in the job role of Assistant Beauty Therapist.



B&WSSCs performance @IndiaSkills 2024



IndiaSkills 2024 was a grand celebration of skills, innovation, and passion. The event kicked off with a spectacular opening ceremony on 15th May'2024 that highlighted the rich cultural heritage of India, setting the stage for an unforgettable journey. Over 900 candidates, including 170+ women, showcased their skills from 30+ states at Yashobhoomi, Dwarka, Delhi, from May 16th to May 19th.

20 States & UTs participated in Beauty Therapy skill along with 2 wild card entries from Assam & Odisha, thus taking the total participation in Beauty Therapy as 22. Pritisha Barman from Assam won the Gold, Rojalin Brahma from Odisha took the Silver, and Tahesin Sutarr from Maharashtra earned a Bronze medal in Beauty Therapy.

In Hairdressing, Yash Chavan from Maharashtra secured Gold, Aryan Sen from Rajasthan claimed Silver, and Avni Sharma from Odisha and Karishma Das from Bihar tied for Bronze.

In yoga, Elanthendral MS from Tamil Nadu bagged the Gold Medal. 3 winners tied for Silver Medal -Madhu Mohan from Karnataka, Ayush Mishra from Chhattisgarh and Pranav Aher from Maharashtra. Pranshu Gahlot from Rajasthan won the Bronze Medal.
