Scope of Work:

Services Delivery Duration and Place: 60 to 90 minutes on 21st November 2025, Delhi/NCR

Participants: 23 competitors, both male and female, who will represent India in WorldSkills Asia 2025 between the age group 17 to 22

Services Required:

The selected motivational speaker/agency will be responsible for designing and conducting an engaging, high-energy motivational session as part of the Team Building and Mental Readiness Program organized by B&WSSC for the finalists representing India in WorldSkills Asia.

The motivational session should:

1. Energize and Inspire:

- Use storytelling, real-life experiences, or interactive techniques to create emotional engagement.
- Include themes such as "Winning with Purpose," and "Pride of Representing India."

2. Address Mental Resilience:

- Tackle pre-competition stress, self-doubt, and performance pressure.
- Share practical tools for maintaining focus and calm under pressure.

3. Encourage Team Spirit:

- Reinforce the idea of unity, collaboration, and mutual respect among participants.
- 4. Include Interactive Elements:
- Use Q&A, visualization exercises, or short group activities to enhance participation.

5. Optional Musical / Poetic Integration:

• The speaker may include motivational poetry, music, or a creative format to deliver the message in a lighter, relatable tone that resonates with young participants.

Objective of the engagement:

The motivational session should aim to:

- 1. Instill a strong sense of national pride and purpose.
- 2. Build confidence, focus, and emotional stability.
- 3. Encourage perseverance, teamwork, and a growth mindset.
- 4. Help participants overcome fear, anxiety, and self-doubt before competition.
- 5. Motivate them to represent India with integrity, discipline, and positivity.

Proposal Requirements:

Interested speakers/agencies are required to submit the following:

- 1. Profile / Company Background: Brief overview, areas of expertise, and years of experience.
- 2. Speaker Profile: Detailed bio, photographs, past client list, and links to sample videos or recorded sessions (if available).
- 3. Session Concept Note: A short proposal outlining approach, themes, methodology, and structure of the motivational session.
- 4. Commercial Proposal: Detailed quotation, including speaker fee, travel, accommodation (if applicable), and other costs.

Eligibility criteria:

- 1. Minimum 8–10 years of experience as a motivational speaker, leadership coach, or corporate/youth trainer.
- 2. Proven experience conducting motivational or behavioural sessions for youth, corporate, or educational institutions.
- 3. Excellent command over English and Hindi; ability to connect with youth audiences.
