About B&WSSC

Beauty & Wellness Sector Skill Council (B&WSSC) a recognised Awarding Body of National Council for Vocational Education & Training (NCVET), promoted by CII, with financial support from the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), under the aegis of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE).

The aim is to focus on establishing an effective and efficient ecosystem for developing and imparting skills in the Beauty and Wellness industry, through relevant content & curriculum, courses, information database, delivery systems and standardization of the accreditation and certification process, to enhance the employability of the Indian workforce globally.

B&WSSC is inviting qualified and experienced training providers to submit EOI for the implementation of a **Skill Development Training Program for Tribal youth** in the districts of Telangana. This initiative aims to enhance the employability and skill sets of individuals in the local community.

Scope of Work:

The selected training provider will be responsible for delivering a residential comprehensive skill development training in NSQF aligned job roles of Beauty & Wellness Sector Skill Council.

Eligibility Criteria of Training Partner:

1. The entity must have trained at least 5000 and above candidates in (STTs) Short Term Trainings under government funded schemes, preferable in Telangana.
2. Training Partner having annual turnover of minimum 15 Cr in the last 3 FY.
3. Proven track record of successful training program outcomes, including 70% participant placements both in wage and self-employment in relevant employment opportunities.
4. Any additional value-added services or resources that may enhance the overall program.
5. The entity must have its active presence in at least two States.

Proposal Submission Guidelines:

Interested training providers are requested to submit their interest by 1st April 2026, 3.30 p.m. Late submissions will not be considered. Proposals should be sent to Swarleen.kaur@bwssc.in with cc to ceo@bwssc.in and should include the following mandatory information

1. Name of the Training Partner with address and SPOC details
2. Organization profile with experience and track record of the projects undertaken (compiled presentation is preferred)
3. Management Profile and team profile
4. PAN and GST of the Organization
5. Balance sheet and ITR (last 3 years)
6. Project completion certificates
7. Minimum 5 LOI's from potential employers
8. Declaration/Undertaking on company letter head with sign and stamp, stating the Training Provider has not been blacklisted from any government department/state ministry/central ministry.
9. If Partners have previously done training under Telangana state, then attach the WO, Previous Performance (Trained – Certified – Placed)
10. Declaration that at least 70% candidates shall be given wage/self-employment.

B&WSSC reserves the right to accept or reject any proposal based on the evaluation criteria. The organization also reserves the right to negotiate with the selected training provider to finalize the terms and conditions.
